Recreational programs, social services, and nursing care all contribute to helping Christian Health Care Adult Day Services' clients lead active, comfortable lives. A full-time registered nurse monitors clients' medical progress, administers medication, and serves as a liaison between doctor and family. Hours of operation are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday to Friday. Door-to-door transportation is provided by wheelchair-accessible vans. Medicaid is accepted, and other financial-assistance programs include the Community Care Program for the Elderly and Disabled, Respite Care, state Gerontology Alzheimer's Program, Veterans Administration, and long-term care insurance.
