Thank you for expressing an interest in being a crafter/vendor at Autumnfest 2026. The 2nd Saturday in October will be here soon, and plans are being finalized for our Autumnfest/craft fair. Please read the guidelines below and submit your contract and payment as soon as possible. Space is limited so sign up early! My address is at the bottom of this contract. If you have any questions or concerns, you may email me at ronnie57@optonline.net. Autumnfest will be both inside and outside this year. Vendors must bring their own tables. Chairs will be provided for indoor vendors. Outside vendors must provide their own chairs. Once I receive your contract and check, I will send you an email stating that I have received it. If you have not received a confirmation email two weeks after you have sent it, please email me and let me know.

PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE CONTRACT, CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE THIS YEAR.

- Registration will begin upon our receipt of the completed application and payment of fees. Spaces will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- The fee is \$42.00 for a 6x8 ft space inside Fellowship Hall / Library area and \$32.00 for outdoor vendors. Outdoor space, using the church lawns, will not have a specific assigned spot.
- Payment will be accepted by check or money order written out to **Pompton Reformed Church**.
- Cancellations will be accepted until Friday September 18th. The event is **rain or shine** and no refunds will be made after September 18th.
- Each outdoor vendor is to be responsible for providing their own tent/pop-up covering as well as tables and chairs. Electricity will not be available outdoors.
- Every vendor is responsible for providing their own tables.
- Indoor vendors will be provided with 2 chairs. Requests for electricity and/or wall space is limited and will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Please note any requests on your contract. If your request cannot be granted I will let you know.
- Please do not infringe on your neighbor's space. Every effort will be made to accommodate every vendor's need.
- No loud machinery, music or loudspeakers allowed.
- Crafters/Vendors must be available at their tables at all times.

- Pompton Reformed Church will not be responsible for any thefts or damage to your property.
- You must be responsible for collecting your own taxes.
- Set-up will begin at 8:00 am. Crafters/Vendors agree to stay until the closing time of 3:00 pm.
- After you have set-up, you will be directed to a designated parking area for vendors. We would like to free up as much of the church parking lot for the shoppers as we can.
- Snacks, hot dogs, hamburgers and beverages will be available for purchase or bring your own lunch. *Please note we will **not** have coffee and bagels available this year.*
- There will be no admission charge to the public.
- Autumnfest will be publicized in all local newspapers, flyers in schools and around town, Facebook, and signage on church property.
